Anaheim Beautiful is proud to announce the 2nd Annual Anaheim Community Pride Poster Contest, formerly known as Green Ribbon Week. The contest is presented by the City of Anaheim Department of Public Works, Code Enforcement Division and Republic Services in partnership with the elementary school districts in the City of Anaheim. Community Pride is a contest offered to all public schools in Anaheim for students, 1st through 6th grade. Our mission is to promote and bring awareness to anti-littering, anti-graffiti and recycling. Students are invited to create a poster on one of the following Community Pride themes: **Recycling, Graffiti-Free, Litter-Free.**

Community Pride Contest winners will be announced during Earth Week (April 22-29), a great time to adopt community pride.

There are three levels to this competition: School, District and City level. Participating schools will receive free posters for students to submit their entries and Community Pride wristbands. The **Contest Overview** and **Guidelines** can be found on the back of the posters. At the school site, please have teachers judge student entries for a first, second and third place (per grade level). Please note names on the attached School Entry Cover Sheet and Checklist form of who won first, second, and third for each grade level (note: one form per school).

Submission Process and Deadline - Posters should be flat and not folded. Student's name, teacher's name, grade level, school and school district must be filled out on the back of each entry. Each school must select a first, second and third-place winner, per grade level. First-place posters (only), from each grade level, will move on to the district-wide competition and are due to the **Office of Curriculum & Instruction (Attn: Kelley Barrett)** by **March 13, 2015**. First-place district winners will move on to compete at a city-wide level.

Certificates will be given to the first, second and third place winners at each school (per grade level). If there are any districts or city winners from your school we will contact you to coordinate a time to give the students their awards.
